SCREENING

13,801 individuals screened (44% Male and 56% Female) across 153 cancer screening camps organised in Mumbai, Thane, Kolhapur, Pune, Nashik, and Vidarbha between the period of July to September 2023.

- A total of 4% were found to be screen-positive, and follow-ups are being made. 1 person has been confirmed with the diagnosis and is taking the treatment.
- The ICS screening department has facilitated and built a capacity for oral cancer screening for the Wockhardt Foundation and Piramal Swasthya.
- ICS screening has initiated the Screening Advisory Committee, chaired by Dr. Anita Borges, to make a uniform and evidence-based standardized protocol for cancer screening in Pan India.




