





• HPV DNA sample collection is performed for cervical cancer screening. • A total of 110 people were screened (37% male and 63% female) at 4 cancer screening camps. • A total of 7.2% were discovered to be screen-positive, and follow-ups are in progress. 4 out of 69 female beneficiaries are found to be HPV DNA positive cases which are navigated and investigated for confirmatory tests and treatment at tertiary health care centre.




