







We are happy to inform you that, the "Indian Cancer Society's Cancer Cure Fund (ICS Cancer Cure Fund)" has completed two years. Donation received from investors in the "HDFC Debt Fund for Cancer Cure" constitutes the ICS Cancer Cure Fund which is used to fund the cancer treatment of needy patients. A total amount of Rs. 1087.33 lacs has been received as donations from HDFC AMC on behalf of the investors till date. This donation to Indian Cancer Society (ICS) has made an invaluable difference in the lives of many needy cancer patients. We are pleased to inform you that since October 2011, the donations received from the investors of the HDFC Debt Fund for Cancer Cure, have been used to grant financial aid for medical treatment to 451 patients aggregating to Rs.951.62 lacs. Of these, more than 80% of the patients are less than 30 years of age. Timely financial assistance for medical treatment can indeed change their lives forever.

CASE STUDIES



Master. Shubashish Tripathy, a 11 year old boy from Dhanupali, Orissa, was diagnosed with Acute Promyelocytic Leukemia at Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai. His father works as an electrician and earns Rs.100/- on daily wages. His father was shattered, when he came to know that his only son suffered from cancer. To add to his despair, the cost of treatment quoted by the hospital was Rs 2.5 lacs. Parents were about to lose all hope, as it was not possible for them to raise the amount. Afact is when the hospital referred their case to Indian Cancer Society's Cancer Cure Fund. His health has progressively improved after the treatment and he is regular at school too. Apart from studies, he is learning tabla and piano and his parents are very grateful to Indian Cancer Society and appreciate the noble cause that the organization does.

Mrs. Kiranben Vijaybhai Pithadiya, a 39 year old female from Ahmedabad, Gujarat was diagnosed with Breast Cancer, at Gujarat Cancer Research Institute, Gujarat. Her husband works as labour & earns Rs.3000/-per month. The cost of treatment was Rs 1lac and her treatment was completed with the sanctioned amount from ICS Cancer Cure Fund. Currently she is taking rest at home . When contacted she said that ICS is a very good organization that not only helps needy patients financially but also regularly take a follow up during the treatment and post treatment. This motivates the family and makes them strong at odd times. Her parents are happy on her recovery and calls ICS regularly to give follow up of her medical status.





Mr. Vishnu Vijayan , a 21 year old male from Ernakulum, Kerala was diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukemia, at Regional Cancer Centre, Thiruvananthapuram. His father works as coolie & earns Rs.800/- per month. The cost of treatment was Rs 3.75 lac. He has completed his treatment and now follows the instructions as per doctor. Currently he has secured a job as driver in a dental company. He meets the family expenses including the education expenses of his siblings. Vishnu is doing well in his daily activities and gives us regular follow up.

Miss.Ashrita Maity, a 15 year old female from Midnapur, West Bengal was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia, at Tata Medical Centre, Kolkata. His father works as an electrician assistant & earn Rs.5000/- per month and was not able to afford the treatment cost of Rs 4 lacs. With the help from ICS Cancer Cure Fund, she has fought cancer and has now confidence to live life to the fullest. Today she goes to school regularly and her father is very grateful to ICS for the help offered in saving her life.





Mr.Pankaj Tiwari , a 17 year old male from Thane, Maharashtra was diagnosed with Osteogenic Sarcoma at Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai. His father works as a driver & earns Rs.5000/- per month. The cost estimate for the treatment was Rs 25 lacs This was impossible for him to manage. Tata referred this case to Indian Cancer Society's Cancer Cure Fund, after which full amount was sanctioned. Pankaj has completed his treatment and is on follow-up . Currently he has finished his school and joined college. His grateful parents have conveyed, "Very big thanks to ICS for their wonderful work."
