Greetings from Ugam on 4th Anniversary Day **Celebrations!**

It has been eventful year for Ugam working towards fulfillment of their mission statement. Ugam's involvement with Relay for Life organized by Ecole Mondiale world school for two consecutive years has culminated in recognition of Indian Cancer Society(ICS)as global official partner for Relay for Life in India by American Cancer Society. This is very important mile stone for Ugam & ICS. Relay for Life will provide platform for creating social awareness about cancer besides being a major fund raising event. Ugam members will have to be ready & well trained for taking on this challenge.

Empowerment of survivors is another important mission of Ugam. Ugam has facilitated the Empowerment of survivors by focusing on educational assistance. Sujaya Foundation in collaboration with Indian Cancer Society provides vocational aid to survivors by facilitating the basic computer courses. One of the Ugam member serves as the trainer. Ecole Mondiale world School in Mumbai provides a secular class where survivors are trained for English language by an able English teacher, motivating them to suppress their social fears. Yashwant Rao Chawan open university provides degree courses to cancer survivors with maximum 50% concession and a gratuity to those who are from poor financial background.

From the Desk of Till date 28 childhood cancer survivors have benefited from these courses.

> The GlaxoSmithKline Pharmaceuticals Ltd sponsored Self Reliant Survivor Project at the ICS Rehabilitation Centre, Parel is yet another avenue for empowerment of survivors. Tailoring has been chosen as the vocational skill to be imparted based on its universal applicability across rural & urban areas, gender, social strata & ease of home based enterprise development. Ugam members are encouraged to make best use of this opportunity.

> Ugam has been given platform to present scientific paper to share these experiences during forthcoming SIOP 2013 conference at Hong Kong. Congratulations to Ugam members for this achievement.

> International Childhood Cancer Survivors Network (ICCSN) which functions under umbrella of International Confederation of Childhood Cancer Parent Organizations (ICCCPO) has put Ugam on their map as an important support group. ICCSN has just published handbook "How to establish a survivors group and keep it going" which can be downloaded via the ICCCPO website www.icccpo.org

> I was surprised to see the similarities between their recommendations & the way we have created survivor's group Ugam in Mumbai without interacting with them on this matter ever. It is common language of passion which we all share wherever we are working for this wonderful group of childhood cancer survivors. Journey of Ugam - 2012-2013

Ugam's 3rd Anniversary: 3rd June 2012



Ugam Celebrated its 3rd Anniversary on 3rd June 2012 at the Choksi auditorium in Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai. The response was very good this year. About 300 survivors, active patients with parents attended the program of which 100 were Ugam members/friends.The event was attended by high profile guests like actor Arjun Kapoor, actor- director Amol Gupte, comedian Suresh Menon, and the students of Subhash Ghai's film institute Whistling Woods.

Mrs. Anita Garware, Hon. Gen. Secretary Center for Child Development (CCD), Mr. Keval Noria, Mr. Ranjan Kapoor, Mr Hari Mundra Managing Committee members of Indian Cancer Society, Dr. S. D. Banavali HOD Medical Oncolgy graced the occasion. Ugam's theme song, sung by well known singer, Shaan assisted by Tarannum and composed by Merlin, was launched by Shashank Johri, who wrote this song during inaugural ceremony. Ugam members presented a skit about cancer, the mental trauma faced by the patients during their treatment and thereafter as survivors and the myths about the disease. The theme of the skit was aimed at encouraging the children present by conveying that cancer is curable and there is life after

cancer. This was followed by certificate distribution to survivors who had completed the computer course conducted by the Sujaya Foundation in collaboration with Indian Cancer Society at the Rehabilitation centre at Parel, Mumbai.

There were 13 coverages in print, 39 online coverage & 4 coverages on radio (Red FM) and TV interviews. This has created a lot of social awareness. Many survivors have started joining Ugam& people from various fields are trying to help this vibrant group & give them an opportunity to showcase their talents for an overall development which will help them to get back to mainstream society.

It was a very special Christmas morning for 200 children suffering from cancer when Ranbir Kapoor, Varun Dhawan, Anurag Basu and other elite personalities visited the Tata Memorial Hospital on 25th December on the occasion of HOPE 2012, an annual event celebrated at the hospital for cancer children. They definitely couldn't have asked anything more from Santa Claus. The children danced, interacted and enjoyed themselves with the guests present. Ugam had made a significant contribution in the event along with the other foundations.



Workshops were held a month before the event wherein children displayed their drawing skills and exhibited their talent in pottery. Around 11 Ugam members participated in the event wherein they presented a skit about cancer, the mental trauma faced by the patients during their treatment and thereafter as survivors and the myths about the disease. The theme of the skit was to encourage the children present to convey that cancer is curable and there is life after cancer.

The Coast Guards spoke about the features and attacking capabilities of the ship. The children were thrilled to be a part of such an event and were very attentive to what the guards had to say. The Guards spoke about their lives on the ship, the hardships faced by them during combats and how proud they are to serve the nation. This was followed by air shows displayed by helicopters. The choppers performed some spectacular stunts by demonstrating their aerial skills and reflexes. The guards also performed a mock rescue operation which is carried out by them during crises. They also deployed some of their patrolling boats into the sea and displayed their surveillance operations. A magic show was also arranged for the kidswhich was quite entertaining. The Captain of the ship urged the children to be strong and not to lose hope during their treatment. Ugam members thanked the guards for giving them an opportunity to visit 'Sankalp'. The Terry Fox Run, in support of bone cancer awareness, took place from the Air-India Building at Nariman Point to the Marine Drive



Flyover and back to the Brabourne Stadium.The participants, mostly comprising of school kids, showed their enthusiasm by holding banners and cheering throughout, watched on eagerly by Bollywood actor, AmitSadh and singer Raageshwari, who flagged off the run with the support of GulKripalani, convenor of the Terry Fox Committee in India. Relay For Life: 15th March 2013



Relay For Life is a 24-hour community celebration which honours all those who are affected by cancer. Relay For Life was established in the 1980s by the American Cancer Society. In recent years the concept has gone global and Relay For Life events are now held in more than 20 countries around the world, where more than 4 million people take part and raise funds and create awareness to save lives from cancer. Ecole Mondiale World School had organized the Relay for Life for the 2nd consecutive year on 15th March 2013.Ugam members were invited to participate in the event. 20 Ugam members participated in the celebrations..Relay for life is an overnight relay walkathon where groups take turns walking around the track till 8am the next day.



'CANCER DOESN'T SLEEP, SO FOR ONE NIGHT NEITHER WILL WE'. This was the attitude illustrated by each and every person present at the event. Relay for life is based on three principles : Celebrate, Remember and Fight Back.The event started with an introductory speech by the students which was followed by speeches given by survivors. Bhaskar Pandey, an Ugam member gave an inspirational speech about his experience in dealing with the disease. The relay started with the survivors lap – an inspirational time when the survivors were invited to circle the track together and help everyone celebrate victories. Ugam members led the walk along with other survivors followed by teachers and students of Ecole Mondiale School. Ugam members were encouraged to speak about their stories in personal interaction session with the student body.

TYACON: 20th and 21st April 2013

2ND National conference on TEEN and YOUNG ADULTS was organized in Delhi at Indian Habitat Centre (IHC) along with survivor's meeting on 20-21st April 2013. 'UGAM' was warmly invited by KCK(Kids Connect Kids), childhood cancer survivor support group from Delhi, to participate in the Survivorship Meet .The first day i.e 20th April 13 was divided into 3 sessions in the 1st session Ugam members were taken to the basement of the CanKids' centre which is in Gautam Nagar were Huma Anis a psychologist taught us how to manage stress and also told us how can we raise our self confidence during and after treatment. The 2ndsession was on 'Self Grooming' and a discussion on "Beauty Industry career option" was another interesting session organised by KCK in collaboration with Blossom a company from the cosmetic industry. Not only did they give us some exemplary tips but also opened doors to many young victors of Cancer who could not complete their education because of Cancer, an alternate career option. The make-over of Mrs. Sampada Sakhre an active UGAM member was just outstanding.



After this we were taken to the IHC where there was a face to face interaction between the doctors, social workers and patients. This was a real fruitful session as many survivors were able to find relevant answers to their queries related to their post therapy problems. Dr.Purna Kurkure & Dr. Laskar from Tata Memorial Hospital were part of the Panel of Doctors , Mrs. Neelima Dalvi, Medical Social Worker from Tata Memorial Hospital was also a part of the panel . Dr. Purvish Parikh, Hon Secretary & Managing Trustee, Indian Cancer Society, encouraged Ugam members during the session. UGAM members also sang their Theme song which was appreciated by everyone present in the auditorium.

The next day i.e 21st began with a really good session organised by Kapil, a leading KCK member and Vivek Arora a consultant from 'Maynardleigh'. Mr. Vivek Arora taught all the members i.e KCK and UGAM members how to create an impact on others with our skills and how to build-up our self confidence. He also taught us how to improve our vocabulary .This session enhanced everybody's profile to a great extent. Later, Ugam members were taken to IHC for the next session where Dr. Brijesh Arora and Dr. Kurkure from Tata Memorial Hospital took over the session with their awareness lectures. Dr. Kurkure also emphasizes on the rights that are denied to Cancer survivors in this 21st centuries and also stressed on the need to change this point of view of the society towards 'Survivors'. In the evening there was a lovely Dinner and Dance Party arranged by the KCK members for the UGAM members at the basement of the CanKids'office at Gautam Nagar where they all enjoyed together. Members were also asked to fill in the feedback forms given by KCK members. TYCON 2013 was really beneficial for all the survivors who attended this survivorship meet as it will not only help the survivors to cope with their problems but also to rebuild their confidence when they met other survivors who are also fighting to survive in this competitive world of today after being Victors. I am Shekhar Jha from Bihar. I am a childhood cancer survivor. I was diagnosed With Hodgkins Disease in Feb 1994 and I was treated in Tata memorial hospital .M y treatment ended in Dec 1994 and as per Doctor's advice I regularly come for follow up. During treatment I never missed my studies and I didn't have any problem in attending school either. I have completed my Post graduation in commerce from L N M University Darbhanga, Bihar in 2012.

I am part of Ugam, childhood cancer survivor group for last 3 years and I am employed in Ugam as Executive Administrator for past one year .Thanks to Mrs. Anita Garware (Director)centre for child development (CCD) for giving me opportunity to work as a coordinator between CCD &Ugam .I will like to thank her on behalf of all Ugam members for her kind support to Ugam.

As a coordinator of Ugam most of the members know me. Thanks to Ugam for teaching me how to face life after cancer. Earlier I used to be very shy and reserved. After I joined Ugam, I got self confidence to deal with people as that's the job of a coordinator. I have added around 50 active members to Ugam from ACT clinic with the help of Doctors and most of them are taking active part in Ugam activities. I feel I have achieved my goal of adding active members to Ugam & I want to continue adding more members as active members are strength of Ugam. I feel a support group like Ugam should be set up in every city to help childhood cancer survivors. I will also like to thank all the members who have supported me during past one year in Ugam .I can't specify names because it's a long list.

After working in Ugam I think I can work in any organization. Ugam and its member have taught me many lessons of life.

Victory Over Caner...

Hi! Friends. My name is Shweta Chawre, and I am 20 years old. I was very enthusiastic as a kid. I was an Athlete, a Runner and a Basketball player. I also loved to draw and paint. In 2008, when I was 15 years old, my right knee started paining badly and doctors did a biopsy and I was detected with Osteosarcoma, a type of Bone cancer. We were sent to Tata Memorial Hospital at once. I had to take 9 rounds of chemo and undergo a total knee reconstruction surgery along with skin grafting. Major part of my right leg was replaced by an implant, followed by 9 months of physio therapy. After two years of treatment, I was able to stand on my legs again and walk. I am very grateful to Dr. Ajay Puri, Dr. Ashish Gulia and Dr. Suresh Pai who helped us in every way, and to my parents and my little sister for standing by my side throughout the treatment.

After cancer life was very different. I was aware that I could not run anymore or play basketball. But at the same time I was really happy that I was a survivor, and looked at life from a different perspective. I completed my H.S.C. in 2010, and now I am in my 2nd year of Animation and Film-Making.

I heard about Ugam a year ago. I too wanted to help them in their activities and motivate others. For me, cancer is now 'Just another word'. If you believe in yourself, Anything is possible!

Life's Turning Point!

Hi! Friends. I am Vanchinathan.

This is a story about an intelligent, hardworking, smart & beautiful person who is in the photograph attached. It is me! Got a smile on your face? (me too while writing this!) keep that intact while reading further.

At present I am working as a Supervisor in a computer department of a processing unit of a printing press.

First Turning Point: I was diagnosed with testicular tumor in the year 1992 and was treated at Tata Memorial Hospital & at Sion Hospital. When I first heard that I was suffering from cancer tears started rolling down my eyes (at that age I was at my best in crying). I was totally shocked. With the help of my family, doctors, social service group and friends I could become victorious against cancer. Financially we were not well off but my family somehow managed to pull things off. My treatment went on for 2 years (I still hate the word chemotherapy) and follow ups were done for 4 years. I am fine now thanks to everybody who had done something in their own capacity for my treatment.

Second Turning Point: In the year 2006 I got my second shock. I got Married (Cancer se jeet gaya yahan fas gaya) and have a boy aged 4 years. Life's good. I want every cancer patient to get married then they will know that cancer life is nothing in front of Married life....ha ha ha would like to elaborate (on married life) but our newsletter won't have space to add other survivors messages.

P.S: I wanted my story to be fun reading so I have made fun of married life. Friends don't be afraid. Just do it.

Now I am fine and have joined Ugam and our doctors have advised me to start follow up again which I am doing. Thanks to Ugam I am thinking of completing my graduation which I had left midway after I got a job to support my family.



My Encounter with Ugam..

Hello Everybody. It is nice to see Ugam moving at such a great pace as new members are enrolling into the group every week. I would like to share something about myself. I was 14. I was young and running around. Cricket, football, Karate and schooling were my daily routine until one day I felt a sharp pain in my right leg near the knee. This continued for around 45-50 days but the pain didn't subside. I got an X- ray done and it turned out to be Bone cancer (Ewing's sarcoma).

The only thing that I knew about cancer was that it kills. But then my treatment started at Tata Memorial Hospital. I endured 14 cycles of chemotherapy and a surgery where 6 inches of my affected bone was amputated and replaced by a stainless steel metallic implant. My treatment lasted for a little more than a year and finally I was declared cancer free. After my surgery I had to learn how to walk again, had to learn to climb steps. I had to learn everything related to the functioning of my leg right from ABCD. It took me 7-8 months to get the strength of my leg back.

7 years down the line I consider myself blessed to have such a dedicated team of Oncologists. They not only saved my life but went into extraordinary lengths to save my leg. Since my treatment I have finished my schooling, completed my graduation in B.Com, cleared C.A. Inter and am currently doing my articleship. I would just like to say one thing to all the survivors who are reading this. Be Proud of being a survivor. You have been through such a gruelling treatment, use it as an antidote to make yourself strong and help others. Ugam is one such platform where survivors meet, share their problems and experiences. I would call it a sanctuary for the Childhood cancer survivors. Be strong, be happy guys.

completed my treatment and was a cancer survivor. While my treatment was on I behaved badly, especially with my Aai. But I love her too much just like I love my SAI BABA. I love my aai, papa, my sister and brother. I do not ever want to repeat this behaviour. After completing my treatment I took admission for the 12th standard and I passed it with a first class. However, after that education became impossible for me, the situation was against me. But with the help of my Aai and papa I completed my diploma in skin and hair therapy and am now trying for job. One day I will achieve each and everything I have planned for myself and my family because I want to be like a BETA (son) for my aai and papa. So friends just take a chill pill. We are the winners and jitna bhi tension ho khush rehkar jina usase bhi jaruri hai. And as one of my Ugam friend says, "AGAR SMILE NA AAYE TO DO BAR AISEHI SMILE KAR LO TISARI BAR SMILE TO AANI HI AANI HAI." SO KEEP SMILING AND HAVE A VERY SMILY AND JOYEFULL LIFE WITH GREAT ACHIEVEMENTS.

Being a survivor makes me very happy. Now I feel that I can do anything and I can achieve success in life. I am very lucky to be member of 'Ugam'. It has helped me to be creative. It helped me to recognise the hidden talent within me. I had never participated in any skit and did so only because of Ugam. I have got an opportunity to be in a skit. It has developed a good Personality. I have gained confidence in myself. Now, I don't have any stage fear. I am very happy that doctors are very much supportive.

Ugam is a cancer survivor group. They support cancer patients. When I was a patient Ugam was not formed. Now, I am happy that Ugam organises various workshop. डॉक्टर ने पिताजी को पैसे का इंतजाम करने के लिए कहां, लेकिन उतने पैसे हमारे पास नहीं थें. तब उन्होने दुसरों से पैसे लेके मेरा इलाज शुरु किया. मेरी मॉ मुझे देखकर रोती थी. उस वक्त मुझे बहुत बुरा लगता था. इस बिमारी के लिए लगनेवाले पैसे हमारे पास नहीं थे, लेकिन पिताजी और मॉ ने दिनरात मेहनत कर के मेरा इलाज शुरु रखा.

अभी 2003 में मै इस ल्युकेमिया के बिमारी से पुरी आजाद हो गई हूँ और आपके सामने हूँ. अभी मैं 11 वी कक्षा में पढ़ती हूँ. अभी मै आप सभी को इतना कहना चाहती हूँ कि आप भी मेरी तरह इस बिमारी से ठिक हो जाएंगे.
